Guests can also enjoy drop-in activity stations and lawn games before and during concerts.

Guests are also encouraged to bring their own picnic (no beverage carry-ins allowed). The Garden will feature a small concessions area with snacks and beverages including wine, local brews, canned cocktails, and non-alcoholic beverages.
