Ground Rules

1. Please do not pick any of the plant material. There will be times when you will be able to feel the plants, but only the field trip guide is allowed to pick anything.
2. Please walk and always follow the field trip guide.
3. For your safety and for the protection of the plants, remain on the paths at all times.
4. Use quiet voices inside the building as not to disturb others.

Guidelines for Teachers and Chaperones

1. Teachers and accompanying adult chaperones are responsible for supervising their groups, which includes discipline and first aid as needed.
2. This visit is for the children. Please do not answer the questions the field trip guide asks the students. Any personal gardening questions should be saved for the end of the field trip.
3. Please avoid chatting with the other adults; it can be distracting and makes it difficult for the students to hear what the field trip guide is saying.
4. Cell phones – please turn them off or silence them during the field trip.
5. Please make alternate arrangements for younger children who are not part of the group.
6. Make sure that yourself and the students follow the Ground Rules.
